



2021 OYLS Cattle Battle Rules

- Cattle Battle: August 27-29, 2021
- Online entry link for the CATTLE BATTLE will be removed at midnight on August 19, 2021 (NO LATE ENTRIES)

Entry Fees will be as follows:

- Showmanship - \$20.00
- Beef Breeding and Steer Entries - \$35.00
- Bred and Owned - \$10.00

PLEASE NOTE: THIS IS A DRIVE, NOT A SHOW! For example, Suzy wins her class, but she is NOT showing a bred and owned animal. Meanwhile Johnny places 2nd IN THE SAME CLASS and IS showing a bred and owned animal. THEREFORE, if Johnny paid his \$10.00 FEE in advance, he will be called back to compete in the Bred and Owned DRIVE. The highest placing bred and owned animal in each class will be competing in the drive for Grand Champion. The second highest placing animal in each class will be on deck to potentially go in for top 5 placing.

- All exhibitors will pay a \$10.00 grounds fee



Stalls will be sold on site this year!

- **Stalls will NOT be available for purchase through the online entry site!**
- **Stalls will be sold on a first come/first serve basis.**
- **Stalls can be purchased for \$50.00 CASH ONLY**
- **Stall purchase includes two bags of shavings.**
- **Stalls will be sold at the ENTRANCE TO THE STALL BARN.**
(On the north side of the arena)



While we will be awarding the top 5 in every division, please refer to the JFCA rules for information regarding series points.

THE FOLLOWING SCHEDULE IS TENTATIVE AND SUBJECT TO CHANGE:

- Agri-Civic Center grounds will open at 2:00 p.m. on Friday
- **Please do NOT plan on arriving early to unload. The Health Inspector will not be on site until 2:00 p.m. You will not be allowed to unload until you have been cleared by the inspector.**

- **Check-in/ Weigh-In:**

4 PM - 6 PM Friday

7 AM - 9 AM Saturday

SATURDAY:

- **Showmanship:** Saturday at 12:00 PM

Ring A: Pee Wee: 4-7 yr. old followed by Junior: 8-11 yr. old

Ring B: Intermediate: 12-14 yr. old

Ring C: Senior: 15-18 yr. old (NOT graduated)

SHOWMANSHIP WILL BE BROKEN DOWN BY 10 OR LESS, NOT BY AGE GROUPS WITHIN THE DIVISION.

Exhibitor must show their own animal in Showmanship

- **Ring A:** Saturday @ approx. 3:30 PM Brahman Bulls followed by Commercial Bulls
- **Ring B:** Saturday @ 3:30 PM American Steers, followed by Commercial Steers, concluding with Bred and Owned Steers

SUNDAY:

- **Ring A:** Sunday 9:00 AM Registered Brahman Heifers followed by American Influence Heifers followed by Brangus Heifers.
- **Ring B:** Sunday 9:00 AM Cross Bred (non-registered) Heifers followed by Bred and Owned Heifers

NOTE: SHOW RING FOR REGISTERED ANGUS, REGISTERED AOB, AND REGISTERED SIMMENTAL WILL BE DETERMINED BASED UPON ENTRIES. LOCATION WILL BE POSTED BY NOON ON SATURDAY.

****At the conclusion of both the heifer and steer shows we will conduct a Bred & Owned Drive. The Supreme Heifer Drive will take place at the conclusion of the heifer show. PLEASE NOTE: BRED AND OWNED IS A DRIVE, NOT A SHOW!** For example, Suzy wins her class BUT she is NOT showing a BRED AND OWNED ANIMAL. Meanwhile Johnny places 2nd IN THE SAME CLASS and is showing A BRED AND OWNED ANIMAL. THEREFORE, if Johnny paid his \$10.00 FEE in advance, he will be called back to compete in the Bred and Owned DRIVE. The highest placing bred and owned animal in each class will be competing in the drive for Grand Champion. The second highest placing animal in each class will be on deck to potentially go in for top 5 placing.



SCHEDULE SUBJECT TO CHANGE

General Rules:

1. All exhibitors must be between the ages of 8-21 years as of July 22, 2021.
2. Each exhibitor/owner assumes all liability in case of death or injury to his/her animal and injury or death incurred by his/her animal.
3. All animals must meet health regulations as specified in the rules for exhibition as required by the Florida Dept. of Ag & Consumer Services.
4. **No entry will be permitted into barn without current health papers. A health inspector will be onsite.**
5. **The owner/exhibitor is responsible for the care and cleanup of his or her animal.**
6. **Any bedding (shavings/straw) must be removed entirely before exhibitor leaves show.**
7. **Barn must be left in the condition it was found upon exhibitor's arrival.**
8. **The Main Arena will be for show rings, fitting/grooming, staging ONLY. NO CATTLE TIES WILL BE IN THE MAIN ARENA.**
9. **Power is extremely limited, and generators are recommended.**
10. **Tents are highly recommended** since exhibitors will need to be working out of their trailers.
11. There will be no maximum number of entries per exhibitor
12. There is a \$35.00 entry fee per head, \$20.00 entry fee for showmanship, \$10.00 entry fee for Bred and Owned, and a \$10.00 grounds fee per exhibitor.
13. Stalls can be purchased for \$50.00 cash. Stall rentals include 2 bags of shavings. **(There are only 130 stalls. They will be sold on site, cash only, on a first come first serve basis.)**
14. Online entries for the Cattle Battle must be completed and paid for no later than August 19, 2021 at this link. **NO LATE ENTRIES**
15. The show will be held at Okeechobee County Agri-civic Center, 4601 Hwy 710 Okeechobee, FL 34974.
16. All exhibitors MUST be a registered member of JFCA to qualify for points.
17. All Heifers must be 24 months or younger as of July 22, 2021.
18. All Bulls must be 24 months or younger as of July 22, 2021 and be shown with a nose ring.
19. Registered Brahman, Brangus, AOB, Angus, and Simmental classes will be broken down by age on registration papers.
20. American Influence and Crossbred (non-registered) classes will be broken down by weight. They must be weighed at check-in!
